THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

The Presidential Chain of Office was created in 1980 by Mary Sartor, M.F.A., University of Colorado, Boulder, for the inauguration of President Arnold R. Weber. The chain was a gift to the university by Mr. and Mrs. David G. Hawthorn, Class of '24.

Colorado gold and silver are used throughout the chain to symbolize the importance of those minerals to the history of the state. The gem stones chosen also consist entirely of minerals from Colorado.

Three pendants are suspended on the chain. The back pendant is the seal of the State of Colorado surrounded by a golden ribbon representing the golden Circle of Knowledge. The top pendant in the front, the seal of the University of Colorado surmounted by an arch set with diamond and topaz, signifies the necessary link between the search for knowledge and its practical application to the world outside the university. The seal is supported at the bottom by the laurel wreaths found in the seal, emblematic of honor and success.

The bottom pendant is centered with a golden topaz indicating man's quest for knowledge. The surrounding ring is paved with fragmented cubes and diamonds which suggest fragments of knowledge with brilliant breakthroughs of understanding.

The chain surrounding these pendants symbolizes the endless but ever-changing cycle of human knowledge.

THE UNIVERSITY SEAL

The University of Colorado has used three seals in its lifetime.

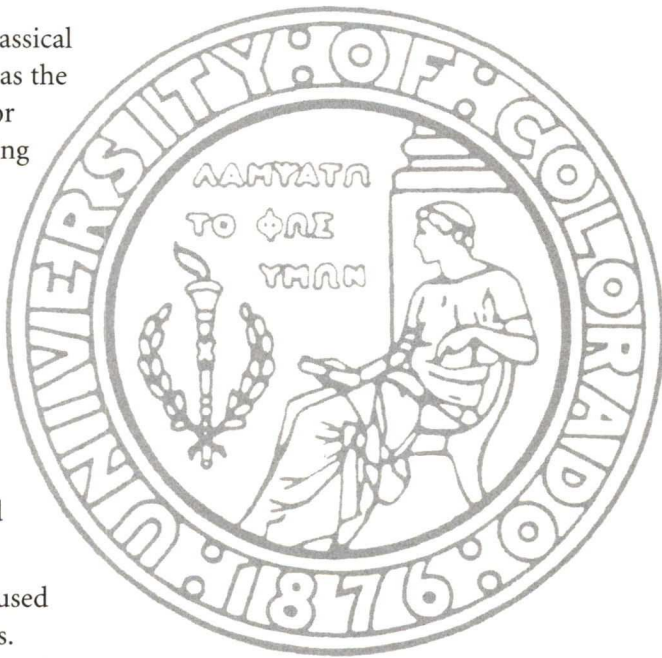
The present seal, adopted in 1908, depicts a classical Greek male figure seated against a pillar and holding a scroll. A burning torch framed in laurel is placed beside him. The Greek inscription means "Let your light shine."

According to Denver designer Henry Reed, the classical design was used because Greek civilization "stands as the criterion of culture." The laurel symbolizes honor or success, the youth of the figure suggests the "morning of life," and the scroll represents written language.

From 1893 to 1908, a seal was used which copies Wyon's medallion, "Science Trims the Lamp of Life." The classical figure of a kneeling Greek woman was flanked by mariposa lilies, which President Baker described as "a true Colorado flower."

Before 1893, a seal was used which essentially copies the Colorado state seal. It was never adopted by the Regents.

The official seal of the University of Colorado is used only by the Regents in transmitting official business.



THE NORLIN CHARGE TO GRADUATES

(From the baccalaureate address by President George Norlin, of the University of Colorado, June 1935)

“You are now certified to the world at large as alumni of the university. She is your kindly mother and you her cherished sons and daughters.

This exercise denotes not your severance from her, but your union with her. Commencement does not mean, as many wrongly think, the breaking of ties and the beginning of a life apart. Rather it marks your initiation in the fullest sense into the fellowship of the university, as bearers of her torch, as centers of her influence, as promoters of her spirit.

The university is not the campus, not the buildings on the campus, nor the faculties, nor the students of any one time — not one of these or all of them. The university consists of all who come into and go forth from her halls, who are touched by her influence and who carry on her spirit. Wherever you go, the university goes with you. Wherever you are at work, there is the university at work.

What the university purposes to be, what it must always strive to be, is represented on its seal, which is stamped on your diplomas — a lamp in the hands of youth. If its light shine not in you and from you, how great is its darkness! But if it shines in you today, and in the thousands before you, who can measure its power?

With hope and faith, I welcome you into the fellowship. I bid you farewell only in the sense that I pray you may fare well. You go forth, but not from us. We remain, but not severed from you. God go with you and be with you and us.”

ACADEMIC DRESS

The tradition of the academic costume began during the twelfth or thirteenth century in the early European universities. Since the clergy composed the majority of the educated class, academic dress is an adaptation of the cape or mantle which was usually of silk or wool and worn by church dignitaries in religious processions.

Through the years, great diversity in color and in style of cap, gown and hood developed. In 1896, the colleges and universities in the United States adopted a uniform code governing academic dress. Today, the black gown, hood, and mortar board worn by the graduates in most institutions follow this code.

While it is not apparent to the casual observer, the gowns worn by the recipients of the various degrees vary somewhat in design. The sleeves of the gown worn by the baccalaureate candidate are long and pointed, while the sleeves of the gown worn by the master's degree recipients are square at one end with a slit at the elbow. The doctor's gown has flowing sleeves with three bars of velvet, and facing of velvet down the front of the gown.

Those who receive a master's or a doctoral degree from the University of Colorado wear hoods lined with the school colors, silver and gold. The hood worn by the doctoral candidate differs in design from that of the master's as it has side panels and is slightly longer. The velvet border of the hood indicates the degree and usually follows the same code as the color of the tassels.

The oxford cap, usually referred to as a mortar board, is black and has a long tassel which is fastened by a button on the top. Candidates for the baccalaureate degree wear the tassel pendant over the right front of the cap before the degree is conferred, then it is worn on the left side. *Summa Cum Laude* and special honors candidates will wear gold honor cords.

BRUCE E. SHEPARD

Bruce E. Shepard is a longtime community leader, successful businessman, and passionate advocate for the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs. He has taken the Reach Your Peak Scholarship Program to new

heights. In addition to his contribution of \$2 million, his passion to provide scholarship opportunities for students serves as a positive example for others.

Shepard's commitment to the Reach Your Peak Scholarship Program is generous, successful, and unprecedented. More than 200 hard-working students benefit from scholarships in this program. In honor of his considerable support, the university will name the scholarship program the Bruce and Anne Shepard Reach Your Peak Scholarship Program.

His dedication to the program is evidenced not only by his fundraising efforts but also his willingness to become personally involved with students of great promise. His commitment to students reaches beyond

the classroom, and he actively communicates with many of them as they progress.

His generosity extends beyond CU-Colorado Springs. He and his wife support over 50 charities including Pikes Peak United Way, the American Heart Association, the Air Force Academy Association, and Multiple Sclerosis Society of Colorado Springs.

Shepard is widely known for his civic involvement, including holding such prestigious offices as president of the Chamber of Commerce, president of El Paso Homebuilder's Association, and two-term member of the city council. He is also one of the founders of the Colorado Economic Development Corporation. His family foundation, the Sheffield Foundation, was named Outstanding Foundation in Colorado Springs in 2003. Shepard also developed the Village Seven residential housing community.

Twice, the University of Colorado has honored Shepard. He was presented with the University of Colorado Distinguished Service Award in 1985 and the University Medal in 2002.

With deep gratitude for his generous contributions and steadfast support, the University of Colorado Board of Regents proudly presents Bruce E. Shepard with the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

Through the vision and dedication of Karen Possehl, CU-Colorado Springs is able to provide scholarship funding for nontraditional female students.

Possehl is dedicated to helping women with great potential, but limited means, pursue college degrees. This focus led her and her husband, Jim, to make a generous gift to UCCS that expanded into a comprehensive, endowed scholarship program, known today as the Karen Possehl Women's Endowment (KPWE).

In addition to providing tuition assistance, KPWE provides funding to students who need help with

childcare expenses. KPWE is widely recognized as one of the most important financial resources at the university, creating extraordinary opportunities for deserving women to pursue academic careers. Each year since 1996, 12-15 women have received funding. To date, 40 women have earned their degrees through the support of KPWE.

Besides Karen's outstanding commitment to UCCS, she has been an active volunteer in the Denver community. She is a longtime member of the Sewall Child Development Center board of directors and serves on the board of the Kempe Center for Abused Children. Karen also serves on the boards of the Hospice of Saint John and the Arapahoe County Library Friends Foundation.

In honor of her many contributions and unwavering support of women, children, and higher education, the University of Colorado Board of Regents proudly presents Karen Possehl with the University Medal.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

JOSEPH WOODFORD

Philanthropy is one of the trademarks of Joseph Woodford. His gift of \$360,000 funded the Center for the Study of Government and Individual and

he has contributed more than \$200,000 in student scholarships for Pre-Collegiate program participants.

In addition to his support of the university, he contributes to the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo, American Heart Association, Urban League, Clean Air Campaign, Colorado Special Olympics, Goodwill Industries, YMCA of the Pikes Peak Region, Boys and Girls Club, Habitat for Humanity, Newborn Hope, and Silver Key. The Colorado Springs Chamber of Commerce Non-Profit Center named him the Outstanding Philanthropist.

Woodford has served as president of Woodford Manufacturing since the mid-1970s and transformed the company into one of the most successful businesses of its type in the country. In recognition of his business success, he received top awards from the Greater Colorado Springs Economic Development Corporation and the Chamber of Commerce.

Woodford's involvement in the Pikes Peak region is incomparable, including service on numerous boards and leadership positions on many of them. His civic engagement includes serving as president of Leadership Pikes Peak, president of the board of the Urban League, membership on the boards of Pikes Peak United Way and the Pikes Peak Foundation, and participation on the Myron Stratton board of directors.

ALUMNI LEGISLATIVE AWARD

WAYNE ALLARD

United States Senator Wayne Allard is a powerful supporter of combining the strengths of the university, the federal government and private business to benefit the

nation. Senator Allard is deserving of recognition.

For more than three years he worked on the development of the Network Information and Space Security Center, a national program to bring together academia, business and government to develop new ways to protect the nation's infrastructure. With his assistance, CU-Colorado Springs forged a partnership with the federal government. He and his staff have worked tirelessly within the legislative process to develop and strengthen relationships at the Department of Defense for important cyber security research. The university is appreciative for his unwavering commitment to issues of national security.

Allard received his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine from Colorado State University and operated a veterinary practice, continuing when he was elected to represent Weld and Larimer Counties in the Colorado Senate from 1983 to 1990. He is remembered for sponsoring state law limiting legislative sessions to 120 days, preserving the concept of the citizen-legislator.

Allard served in the U.S. House of Representatives from Colorado's Fourth Congressional District from 1991 to 1996, when he was elected to the U.S. Senate. As a Colorado congressman, Allard served on the Joint Committee on Congressional Reform. He is also a member of the Senate Banking, Housing and Urban Affairs Committee, where he is the chairman of the Housing and Transportation Subcommittee.

Beginning in the 108th Congress Allard was selected to serve on the Environment and Public Works Committee, which includes two subcommittee assignments, the Fisheries, Wildlife and Water Subcommittee and the Superfund and Waste Management Subcommittee. In January 2003, Allard accepted an assignment by Senate Majority Whip Mitch McConnell to serve as a Deputy Majority Whip. He is also the Chairman of the Senate Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Caucus. We are pleased to present Senator Allard with the 2004 Alumni Legislative Award.
